

Dear Potential Sponsor,

We are writing to ask your organization to sponsor the wrap-up workshop for the 6<sup>th</sup> Dialog System Technology Challenge (DSTC6) which will be held at Long Beach on December 10<sup>th</sup>, 2017 right after NIPS. DSTC, the Dialog System Technology Challenge, has been a premier research competition for Dialog Systems since its inception in 2013. Neural approaches have started to show first promising results in this area. DSTC6 is focusing on how to apply End-to-End technologies to Dialog Systems in a pragmatic way. We have released baseline setups consisting of data, models, and training tools, and participants are now developing their systems. For the final evaluation, the test sets will be provided on Sep. 25th and the results submitted by Oct. 8th. Currently more than 100 people are registered in DSTC6. We plan to have a wrap-up workshop to review the state-of-the-art performance and novel approaches on the DSTC6 tasks and discuss the next directions for dialog technology challenges. We will invite general technical papers for End-to-End dialog technologies and keynote speakers who have proposed cutting-edge approaches for dialog related technologies. After this workshop, we will organize a special issue for End-to-End dialog technologies for DSTC6 in the journal of Computer Speech and Language.

We are starting to solicit sponsorship for DSTC6.
